PILOT REGION: TRB2

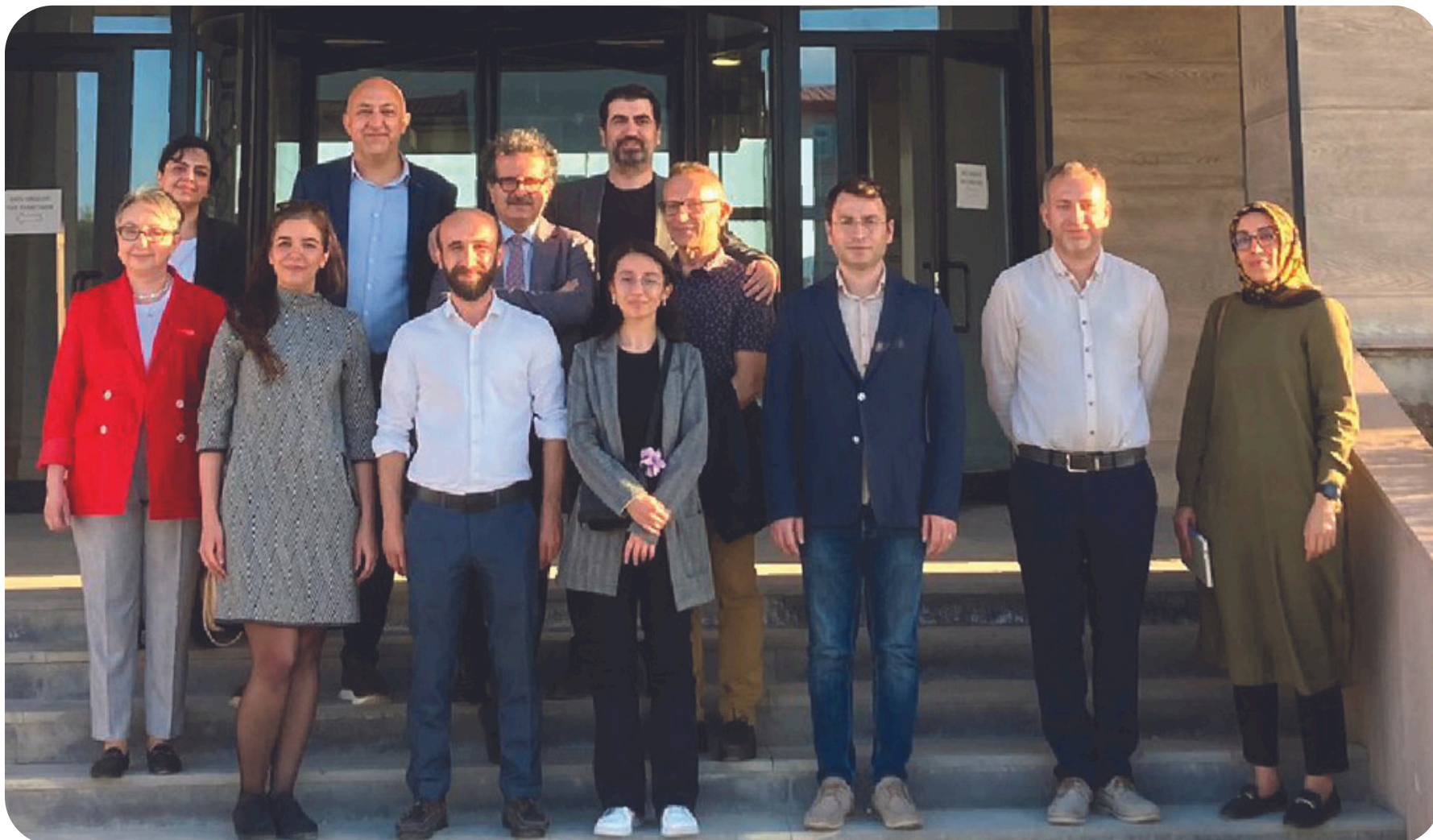
VISIT TO TRB2 NUTS II LEVEL REGION

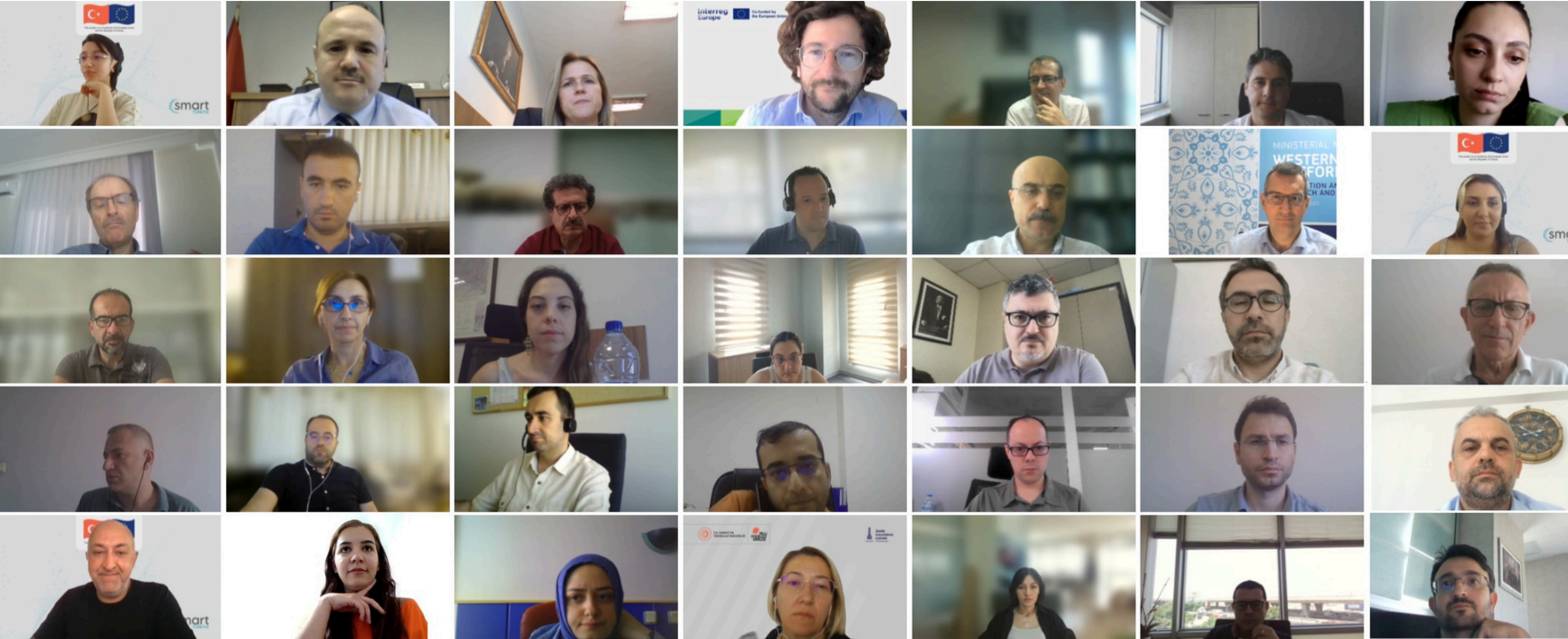
